

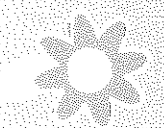
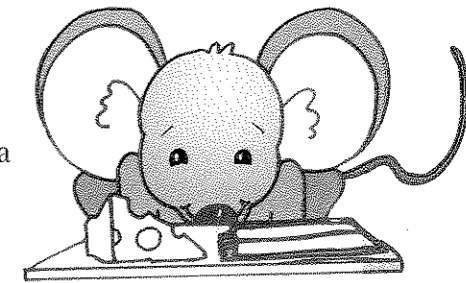
### May 17

- Baseball season is up and running. If you worked at a ballpark, what job would you want and why?

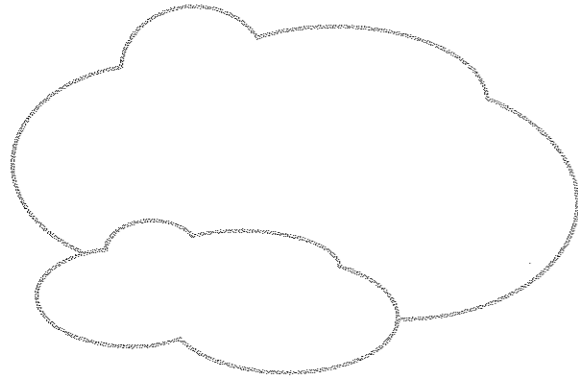


### May 21

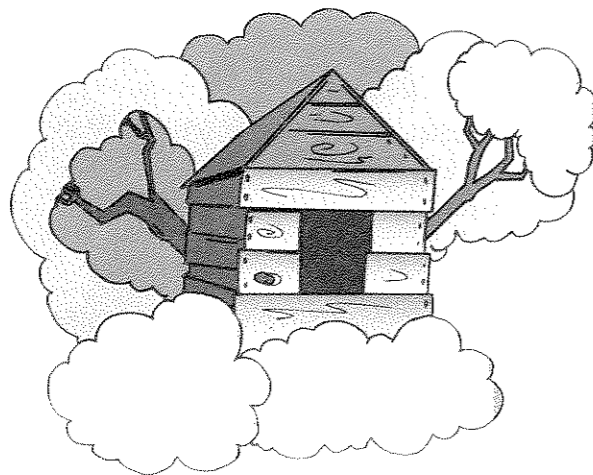
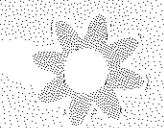
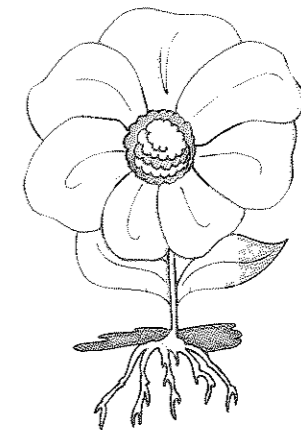
### May 19
