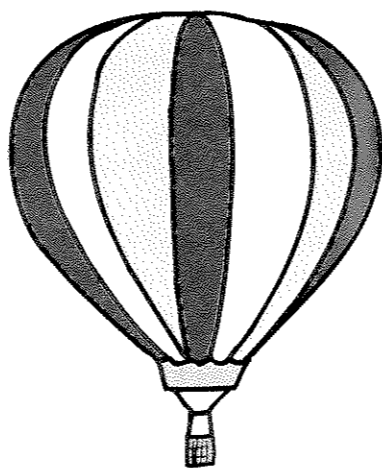


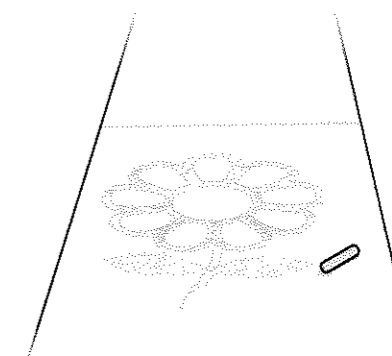
### June 1

- If you could invite anyone in the world to go on a picnic with you, who would it be? Why?

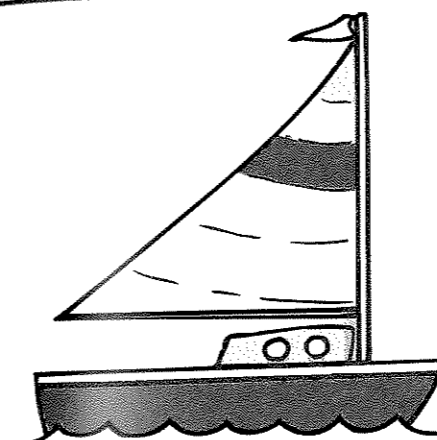

- If you could take a vacation anywhere in the world, where would you go? Why?

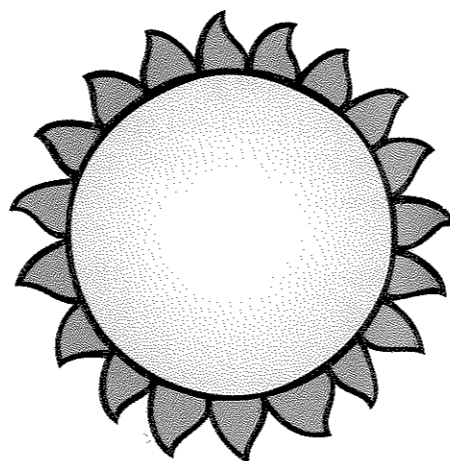


### June 6

- What do you like to do on a sunny day? Write about two of your favorite sunny day activities.



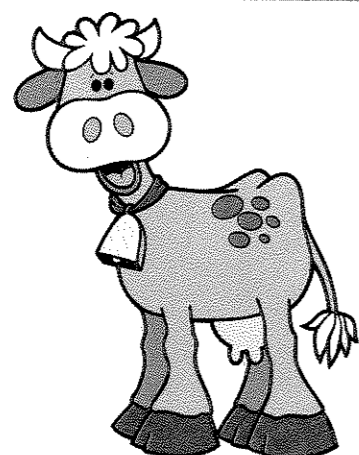
### June 7

- Is it more fun to play inside or outside in the summer? Why?



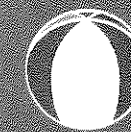
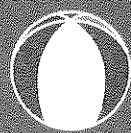
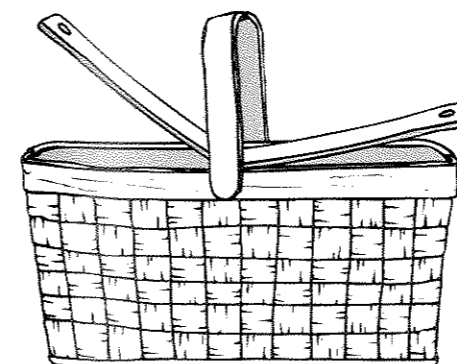
### June 4
