

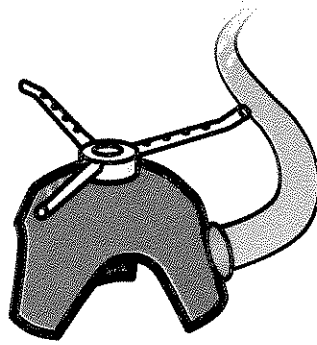

 June 9 is Donald Duck's birthday. He was "born" in 1934. Imagine that you could give him a birthday gift. What would you give, and why?

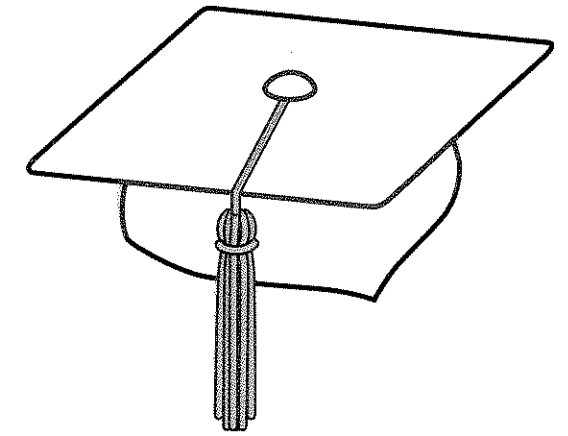
 Is it more fun to run through a sprinkler or to be squirted with a water pistol? Why?

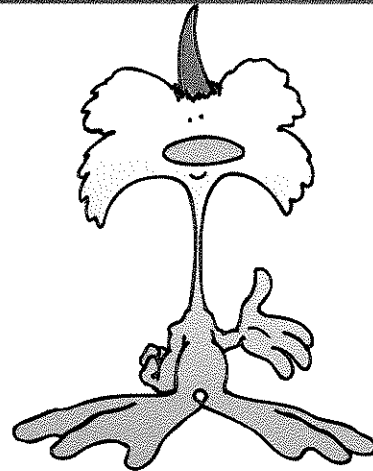
 June is National Frozen Yogurt Month. Would you rather have frozen yogurt or a Popsicle®? Why?


 Graduation happens at the end of school. How is graduation also the beginning of something?




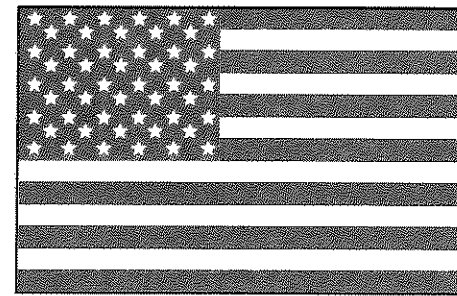

June 14

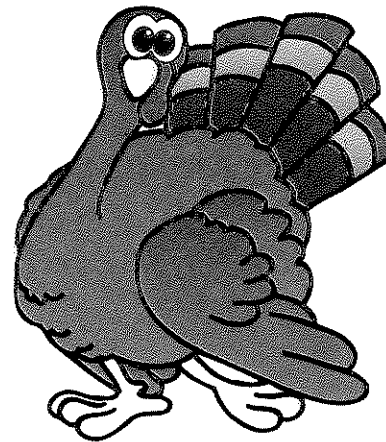
 June 14 is Flag Day. Why do you think we pledge allegiance to the flag?

 June is Turkey Lovers' Month. Would you rather be a turkey or a penguin? Why?

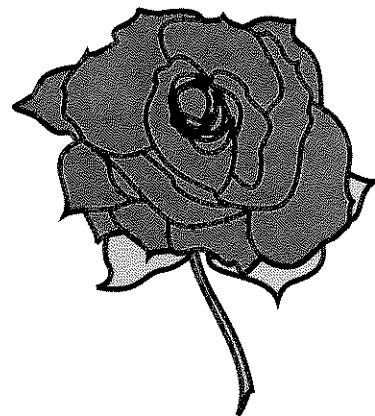
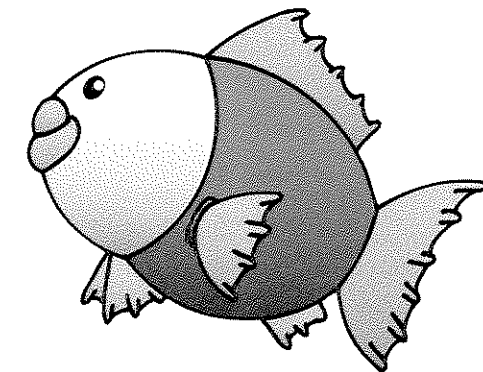
 Imagine that you built a rocket to visit the sun. Write about your rocket and tell about its special features.

 Father's Day is the third Sunday in June. Write about what makes your dad different from everyone else's.

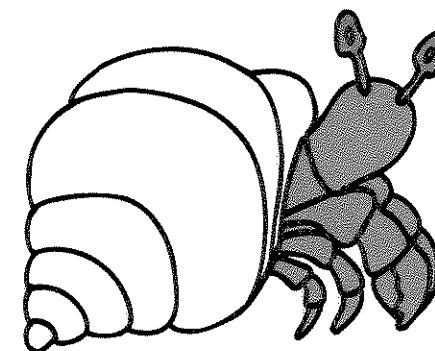
 Imagine that you have caught a fish and it begins talking to you. Write about your conversation.
