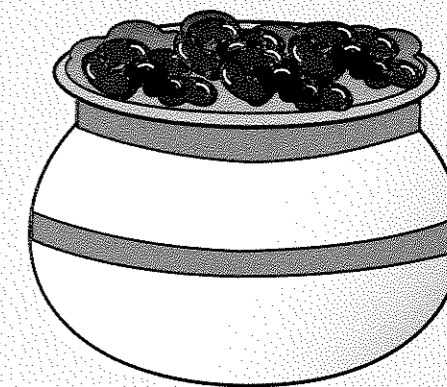
- July 1 is International Joke Day. Write about the funniest joke you've ever heard. Tell why it made you laugh.
- On July 1, 1874, the first U.S. zoo opened in Philadelphia. If you could be any zoo animal, which one would you want to be? Why?



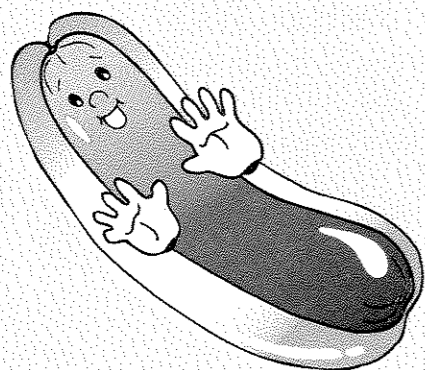

- What would you do if your friend was playing with matches?

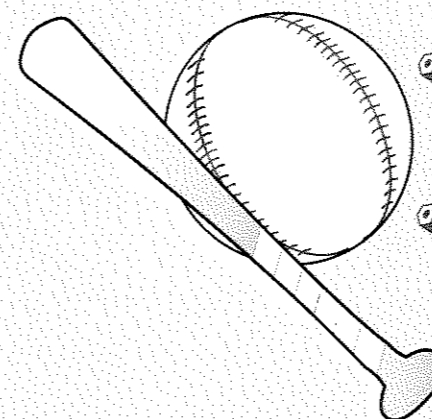


July 2

- July is known as National Hot Dog Month. Pretend that you are a hot dog. Persuade someone *not* to eat you!

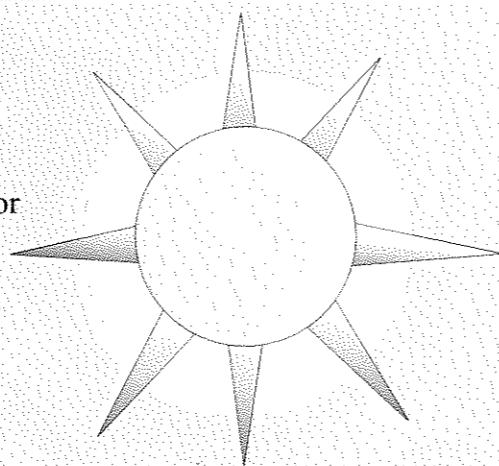
July 6

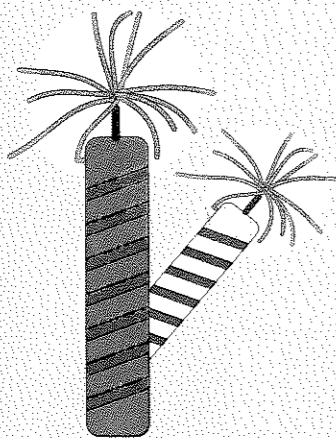
- Imagine you are taking a vacation this summer. List the five most important items to pack in your suitcase. Explain why those items are so important.

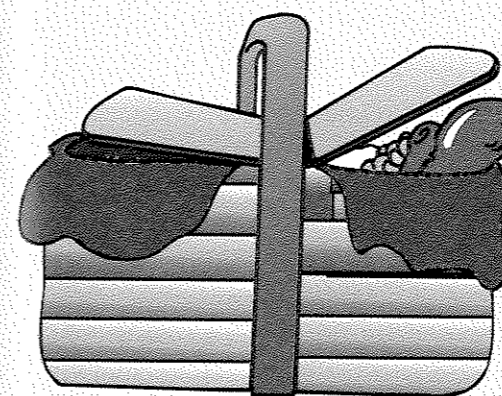
