- Create a new game that could be played in a swimming pool. Describe the game and its rules.

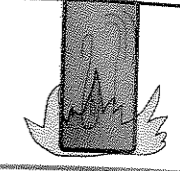

- If you could change your name, what would you change it to? Why?

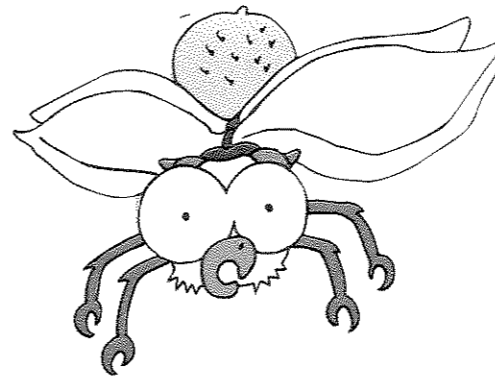
Pool Rules

3. No food in pool



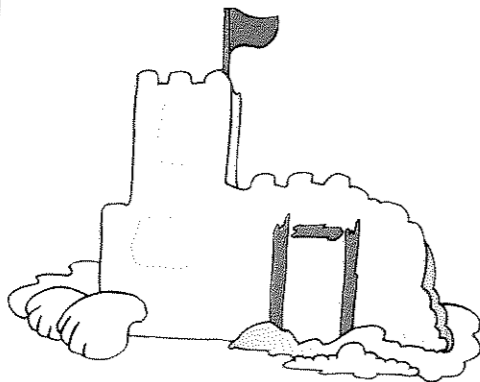
July 22

- Write a story about an adventure in space. Include some of your friends as characters in your story.



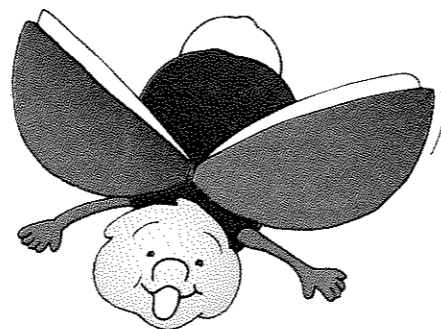
July 18

- Many people go camping in the summer. How do you feel about camping?



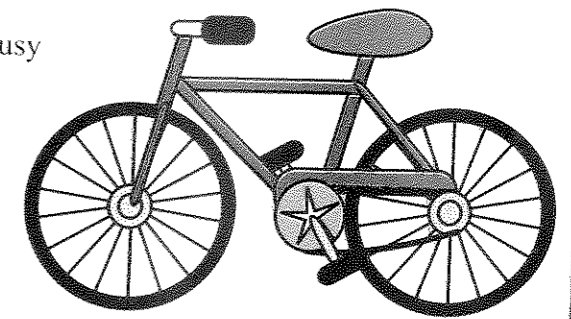
July 19

- A Popsicle® is a popular summertime snack. Do you think that it would also make a good wintertime snack? Why or why not?



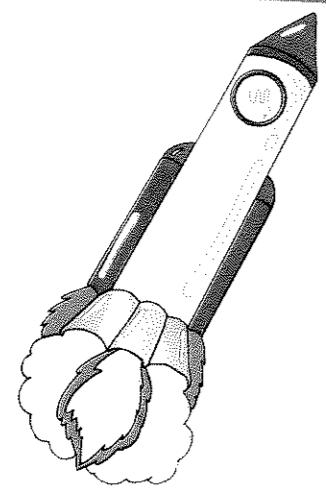
July 23

- If you went for a long bicycle ride and got lost, what would you do?



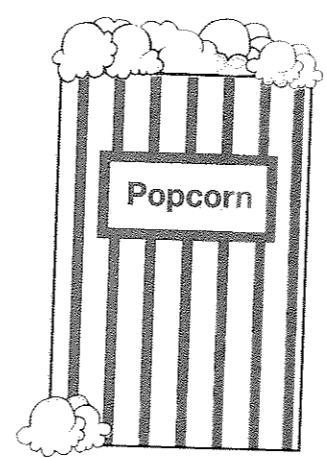
July 20
